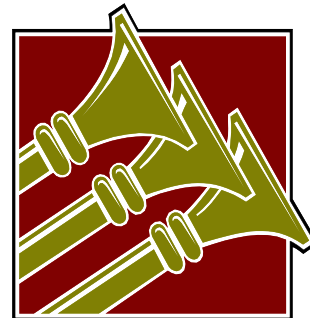

REKINDLING THE FLAME

“Stir up the inner-fire, the gift God gave you....”
2Timothy 1:6

Power can be used in at least two ways: it can be unleashed, or it can be harnessed.

The energy in ten gallons of gasoline, for instance, can be released explosively by dropping a lighted match into the can. Or it can be channeled through the engine of a car in a controlled burn and used to transport a person 350 miles. Explosions are spectacular, but controlled burns have lasting effect, staying power.

The Holy Spirit works both ways. At Pentecost, the Spirit exploded on the scene; the divine presence was like "tongues of fire" (Acts 2:3). Thousands were affected by one burst of God's power. But the Spirit also works through the church—the institution. God began to tap the Holy Spirit's power for the long haul. Through worship, fellowship, and service, Christians are provided with staying power.

This Summer I will be presenting a sermon series entitled “The Acts of the Holy Spirit” – a look at first six chapters of the Book of Acts. These chapters describe the birth and development of the Christian Church once the disciples of Christ received the promised empowering presence of the Holy Spirit. There is much to learn from these stories. The Spirit is the Mover and Shaker behind the scenes in the book of Acts (just as he is in the prequel of Acts – the Gospel of Luke). Today the same Spirit works in the same way. We need a few explosions as well as the controlled burn. Join us for worship and fellowship and hopefully – renewal.

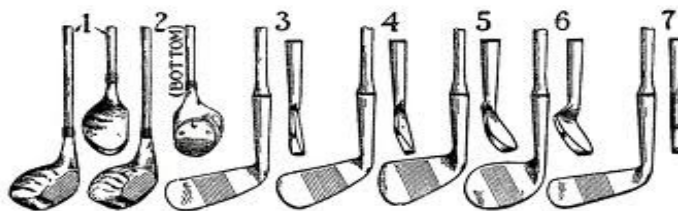
An anonymous donor has pledged to match
